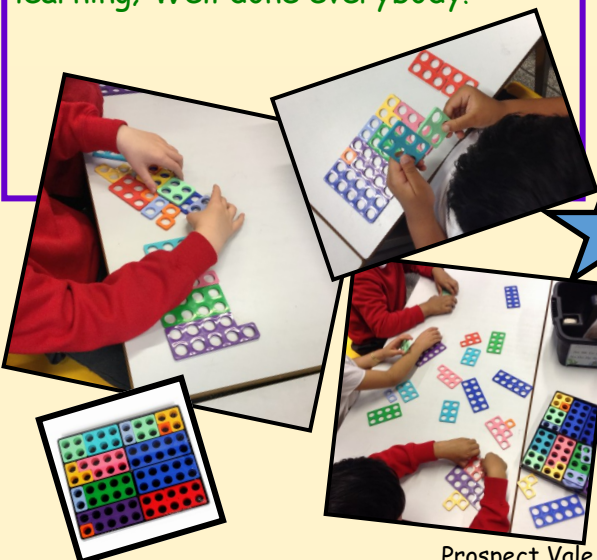
Numicon Visitors
