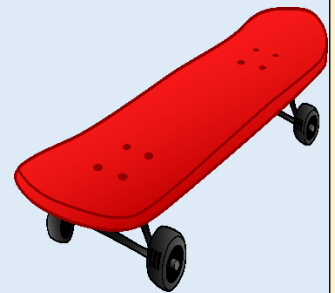




SKATEBOARDING DAY

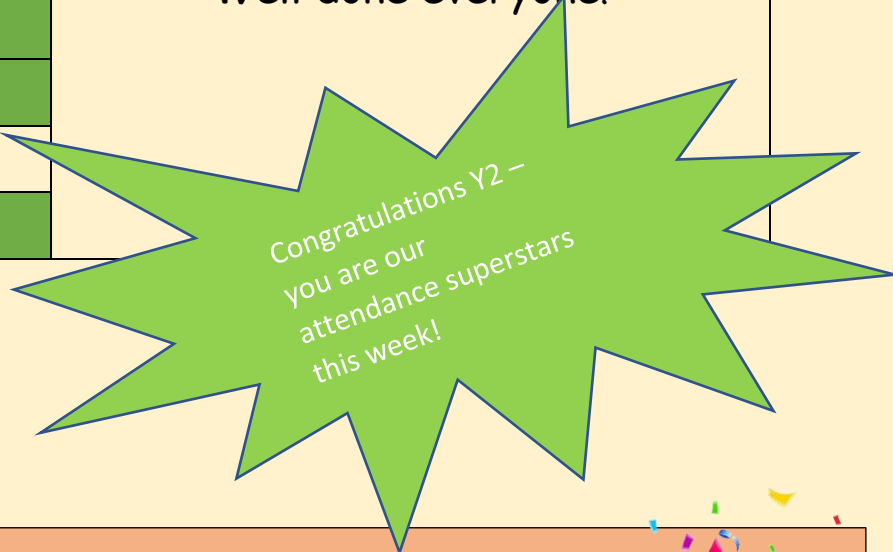

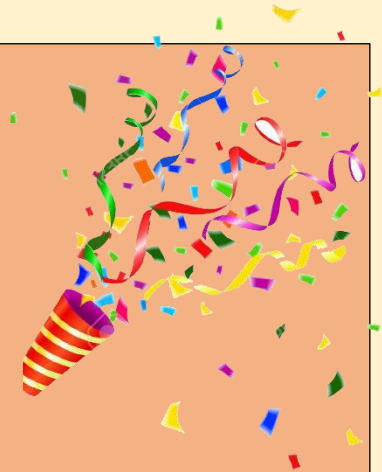
