


Y6 travelled to our capital city on Wednesday.

#### Music Matters - a message from Mrs White

Last week, children in Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 were treated to a demonstration of different brass instruments which will be available to learn from September (parent funded). Please see the attached leaflet from Mrs White for more details about the different brass
